It has been nearly thirty years since New Zealand's Public Advisory Committee on Disarmament and Arms Control (PACDAC) was established. Created by the Nuclear Free Zone, Disarmament and Arms Control Act in 1987, PACDAC's main responsibilities are to:

- Advise on disarmament and arms control issues
- Advise on implementation of the Act
- Publish public reports about New Zealand's disarmament and arms control policies and activities
- Make recommendations for granting money to projects that promote public understanding of disarmament and arms control

The current members of PACDAC are convening a series of open meetings in Auckland, Christchurch, Dunedin and Wellington. We would like to hear from people with an interest in disarmament and arms control to

- Learn about disarmament and arms control-related activities, research or other work happening in the non governmental sector in New Zealand
- Discuss how New Zealanders can make an active and effective contribution to disarmament and arms control
